



Donor Privacy Policy

Philosophy: By protecting the privacy of donor information. A nonprofit helps build public trust.

Standard: Habitat for Humanity of Monroe will provide the donor privacy policy by request. This policy describes how donor information is used and collected. It also allows donors to “opt-out” of making their private information available or shared. Habitat Monroe also has a discontinue contact policy guaranteeing that donors can be removed from solicitation and other mailing lists.

Privacy Policy: Habitat for Humanity of Monroe is committed to respecting the privacy of our donors. We have developed this privacy policy to ensure our donors that donor information will not be shared with any third party.

What information we collect: Habitat for Humanity of Monroe uses various information from persons donating to the organization that includes: amount donated, address, telephone number, donor comments, and e-mail address.

How we use that information: Habitat for Humanity of Monroe will never publish, sell, trade, rent or share names (unless released for publication), e-mail or mail addresses, or telephone numbers of donors. Habitat for Humanity of Monroe will use contact information (e-mail, telephone number, and address) of donors for these purposes only:

- Distribute receipts for donations
- Thank donors for their donation
- Inform donors about upcoming fundraising and other activities of the Affiliate
- Internal analysis and record keeping
- Reporting to relevant U.S. and State agencies (these reports are not for public inspection)

No Sharing of Personal Information: Habitat for Humanity of Monroe will not sell, rent, or lease donor personal information to other organizations. The identity of all our donors will be kept confidential. Donations from persons will not be publicly announced unless authorized by the donor.
